Jacky Ickx, Vincenzo Lancia and Daniele Cotto.

This keenness becomes a venture in 1998 with taking over the organization and make a world wide known race; able to conjugate great performances, an experience into the wilderness and the pleasure of joined amusement.

The great care dedicated to this venture took the competition to the FIM World Championship of Rallyes Tout Terrain in 2000.

4. ITINERARY

The Pharaons 2007 is back to its original seven stages, quite appreciated by all pilots. The start will be, as per tradition, from the outstanding frame of the Giza plan, below the Sphinx. Almost three thousand km in all, with transfers lessened in order to reach the Siwa Oasis - the starting point of the Western desert exploration done by pioneers at the beginning of the Twentieth century. Baharia, Sitrah and Siwa are the Oasis touched this year, enchanting sites with their mysterious thousand years history. A route that will offer an extraordinary variety of grounds that doesn't delude all lovers of technical and demanding tracks, definitely a challenge for men and vehicles which find themselves deep into the most outstanding landscapes of the entire Sahara.

5. TRANSPORTATION AND LODGING

Oct 19 th - 20 th	Vehicles arrival in Genoa (TENTATIVE date, to be confirmed)

Transportation fees:

Bike	720 €
Quad	1.100 €
Car	2.000 €
Truck	1.000 € fix + 500 € linear meter

The person in charge of vehicle embarkation must attend the port of Genoa with:

- his own ID document
- the vehicle owner's passport copy
- an authorisation on the headed paper if the owner is a company
- vehicle log book

Days and time set for vehicles embarkation must be compulsory respected. The drivers are reminded to leave a copy of the start key on the vehicle. The shipping agent and JVD International are not responsible for any robbery from the vehicles. It is advised to use boxes with locker.

All the vehicles not fitting the previously declared height and length on the entry form, will be refused embarkation. [The insurance conditions are those of Ignazio Messina S.p.a., if you wish a complementary insurance you should refer to your personal broker.](#)

Flight + Hotel fees:

JVD International offers the 950 € forfeit fee for flight and hotel per person: return flight A/R to Cairo (departures from Europe according to EgyptAir flights availability) + 4 nights (half board - double room) at InterContinental Pyramids Park Resort ****Hotel in Cairo (Sept 28th-29th / Oct 6th-7th.)

The A/R flight tickets are e-tickets starting from 2007 and they'll be forwarded by e-mail message or their code will be communicated by phone.

The general conditions of passengers and luggage transport are those of EgyptAir. The luggage weight allowed to individual passengers in tourist class, is 20 kg each person.

The entry fees include: rights of sport registration, 6 desert bivouacs (breakfast, basket lunch and dinner), prize giving ceremony, insurance, medical repatriation.

The entry fees DO NOT include: drinks and extras at the bivouacs/hotel, unique GPS, Iritrack system, claxon Sentinel, Balise.

Meals:

Breakfast: served 2 hours before the first motorbike start till 9,00 a.m.

Lunch (Basket Lunch): delivered to each participant in the morning at breakfast. Option to lunch at the bivouac, between 12.00 and 4.00 p.m. at your charge (around 20 €).

Dinner: in the evening at the bivouac from 07.00 no stop till 11.00 p.m.

An identification - not replaceable - bracelet will be delivered along the administrative verifications. It must be worn all time along the rally: it's needed for meals at the bivouac, in order to get water and basket lunch and also to access the prize giving ceremony.

6. FUEL

The Total 95 octane gasoline is available this year. It's anyway possible to order the Avgaz and its forms are available on the website www.jvd.it. Whoever will order Avgaz must fill in all requested data and send through fax to TRAVCO (in Cairo, Egypt) and in copy to JVD International (in Turin, Italy).

9.2 Medical repatriation and medical exemption

The organization has subscribed an insurance with medical repatriation with **EuropAssistance**.

Addressees: pilots
 assistants
 staff
 press resepresentatives
 organization guests
 officers

In case of accident, the Rally medical team organizes the transportation of the addressee from the accident site to the Rally bivouac or to the nearest concerned medical unity, with land and/or air transportation at Rally's disposal.

The medical team will take their decision on the sole ground of medical concern and according to the medical measures in force.

This contract guarantees:

- the transportation from the accident site to the most suitable medical structure according to the injured conditions either by helicopter or by organization vehicles.
- repatriation to Europe on airline flight on seat or stretcher.
- the evacuation of the most severe cases with a dedicated medical flight toward a European hospital. **WARNING:** addressee repatriation for non European resident, will be at his charge starting from Milan (Italy) to his resident Country. It is therefore advised a specific insurance guaranteeing those expenses coverage.
- the transportation airport/hospital on ambulance is guaranteed upon arrival as well as the proper hospital service search.

9.3 Individual accident insurance

The Italian pilot sport licence covers the individual accidents as death, disability and medical exemption.

The competitor should inquire their National Federation in order to know the guaranties agreed to their sport licence as pilots.

It is anyway recommended the subscription of a complementary insurance with your broker or with the broker attending the administrative verifications.

12. GENERAL INFORMATION

Formalities: compulsory valid passport with 6 months validity from the date of entry in Egypt.

Time zone: the rally follows the Egyptian time: summer time UTC/GMT +2h

Money: 1 € = about 7.699 Egyptian Pounds

Money not convertible neither exportable.

Exchange offices are at the airport and in the hotel.

Briefing and modifications of the road book: at 7.00 p.m. below the tent

Water: drink only bottle mineral water

Road Book: PC Course: definite delivery between 5.00 and 7.00 p.m. for the next day stage. The names of pilots authorized to collect the Road Book after the fixed timing (caused by missed arrival at the bivouac) will be communicated by cars and bikes race directors.

Vaccinations: no compulsory vaccinations. Take your usual drugs, foresee salts supplements, Band-Aids, disinfectant, aspirins, anti-diarrhoea, sore throat and cold drugs, anti mosquitoes lotion, sun screen, sun glasses...

Valuables: in no case, the hotel nor JVD International will be considered responsible for possible loss and thefts. As a general rule, take with you your documents and don't take with you jewels and valued objects.
