Supplement extra per person (to be paid together with the entry fee)
Single room: € 280,00

Airport taxes: subject to variations by airlines and other referred boards to a maximum of € 50,00

PHARAONS INTERNATIONAL CROSS COUNTRY RALLY

September 30th – October 9th, 2006

It is more **2 months** to the Pharaons International Cross Country Rally 2006 start and **everything is ready** for the big challenge in the Egyptian desert that by 9 years is running with an increasing success. The course, of about **3000 kilometres**, that from the Sphinx of Giza will take in the first time the convoy in direction of the south oasis, then towards the Libyan frontier, with the unfailing "pearl" of Siwa, has already takes a definitive shape and will propose to the participants a variety of sceneries and grounds that you can find only in Egypt.

Travco, the new logistic partner of **JVD International**, is arranging everything to receive in the best way pilots, assistants, journalists, accompanying people and who will participate at the tourist raid.

MORE THAN 70 REGISTERED MOTORBIKES

The increasing success of the Pharaons Rally, by this time considered by all the most complete rally after the Dakar, at the 30th June, deadline of the second entry fee, caused the inscriptions of more than seventy motorbikes and quads, a really high quantity in comparison with the races of World Championship that precede the Pharaons. At the start there will be the winner of the last edition, as well as the last Dakar, the Catalan **Marc Coma**. His main antagonists will be the French **David Casteu**, the other Catalan **Jordi Viladoms** and the Chilean **Carlo De Gavardo**.

JUTTA KLEINSCHMIDT AND BMW AT THE PHARAONS

It's a last news the passage of **Jutta Kleinschmidt** at the **Team BMW X-Raid**. 16 Dakar to her credit, first on motorbike and then by car, and the wonderful win obtained in 2001, are the exceptional curriculum of the German driver, called to a new adventure in the team managed by Sven Quandt. The team has chosen the Pharaons Rally for the debut of Jutta on the new **BMW X3CC**, the ideal ground to prepare at the best the Dakar 2007. Together with Jutta other three BMW, the other X3CC



entrusted to the French **Guerlain Chicherit** and the X5CC driven by the Spanish **Josè Luis Montereiro** and by the Brazilian **Paulo Nobre**. At the moment the antagonists more dangerous for the Team X-Raid are all French: be careful to **Christian Lavieille**, **Dominique Houiseaux** and **Etienne Smulevici**.
